- Welcome
 - Maria Clark welcomed school council member and guests. She then introduced herself and shared a little about herself. Twitter handle was shared, and administration team was introduced.
- Introductions of members
 - Members introduced themselves and gave a reason for wanting to be a part of the school council.
- Introduction of any guests
 - Matt Harper introduced himself
- Meeting dates for the year

- Elections
 - Ms. Clark asked if the members were agreeable with one of the Assistant Principals serving as secretary to take notes. There were no objections.
 - Chairperson- Heiko Ramirez
 - Vice Chairperson- Karen Mack

- Topics for the Year
 - Suggestions for topics from team: The members were asked if they had topics. No one offered any topics at this time.
- School updates

- East Side Profile/Class Size
 - Our enrollment is 1225 currently. Ms. Clark displayed a demographic data pie chart to show the breakdown of this data.
 - Student class size data by grade was also displayed. This varies each year. Kindergarten is the 'great unknown'. 4th grade is our largest class size and we have historically seen this pick up at 4th grade. She shared that we are fortunate to have one special education inclusion teacher in 1st and 2nd grade and two co-teachers in 3rd, 4th, and 5th.
- CCRPI/Achievement information
 - Our CCRPI data was displayed and reviewed. Our score is 93.1, making us the 9th in all of Cobb County. Content Mastery, Progress, Closing the Gap and Readiness. Maria Clark explained the points and how they are calculated for each group. She reviewed data points in each area and compared the change from last year.
 - In summary, Maria Clark noted these points about East Side: Largest in Cobb, STEM certification in Cobb, Teachers College Workshop model implemented K-5, K-3 teachers trained in OG, and Implementing CCC. We are a high achieving school, community focused and inclusive to all learners.

 - Maker Space teacher salary and supplies is the biggest chunk of money.
 - Technology refresh, turf project, OG support, conferences, etc. are other areas the Foundation funds.
